

How you can help

🐾 Recording is really easy and anyone can do it. Even if you only ever send in one record, that can make a huge difference.

🐾 Record the mammals your cat kills and brings to the house.

🐾 Record the dead mammals you see on the road when you are driving to work.

🐾 Record the mammals, their tracks and signs when you are out walking.

🐾 Get involved with specific species surveys such as dormouse surveys, nut hunts or otter spotting.

Your records are then used to monitor distributions and populations and provide vital information for habitat management.
